

Living Room Cleaning Checklist

Adjust the cadence to traffic, pets, guests, materials, and visible condition. Follow product labels and manufacturer care instructions.

Quick Reset - Daily or as needed

- Return dishes, trash, and out-of-place items to their proper locations.
- Straighten pillows and fold blankets using the household's preferred setup.
- Wipe visible spills with a product approved for the exact surface.
- Vacuum open high-traffic areas when crumbs, hair, or soil are visible.

Routine Clean - Weekly or as needed

- Dust accessible furniture, shelves, decor, frames, and lamp bases.
- Clean the television and remotes only by their manufacturer instructions.
- Vacuum rugs, carpet, edges, and accessible hard floors; mop only as approved.
- Clean mirrors and interior glass with material-appropriate directions.

Detail Work - Monthly or as needed

- Dust reachable fan blades and light fixtures with power off and stable access.
- Vacuum upholstery and cushions only when the care label permits the method.
- Clean blinds, curtains, and drapes according to their care instructions.
- Move only safe, manageable items; clean accessible areas beneath and behind them.

Seasonal and Property-Specific

- Rotate or clean rugs only when their construction and care label allow it.
- Clean baseboards and washable wall marks with a tested, compatible method.
- Reorganize shelves or cabinets only with household approval.
- Report stains, odors, damage, moisture, pests, or unknown residue for review.

Cleaning does not repair damaged materials or guarantee stain or odor removal. Never mix products.
